



HISTORY

The Bonner Advisory Board (BAB) was launched in 2009 to provide an outlet for student voice to the Bonner Foundation and for connection amongst the national Bonner network. Any Bonner student who is committed to the Bonner program and seeks a way to contribute to the national network is encouraged to apply. Approximately ten motivated and passionate student leaders are selected to serve on the BAB each year. Though the role of the BAB has evolved from year to year, they always play a unique and instrumental role in feedback, facilitation, and support for national Bonner initiatives and national meetings (such as Bonner Congress and Summer Leadership Institute).

- Act as an outlet for student voice to the Bonner Foundation
- Assist in the planning and facilitation of Bonner conferences: SLI and Congress
- Assist in the recruitment process for future BAB members
- Attend monthly conference calls via Zoom Meeting
- Provide feedback and generate ideas on national initiatives, such as the Ideas to Action Project
- Represent his or her own Bonner program, the Bonner Foundation, and Bonner peers
- Seek out innovative ways to connect the Bonner Network regularly via social media, webinars, and newsletters
