Bonner Interview Facts

Scholarship Requirements:

- 10 hours each week during school year
- 280 hours in the summer for at least 2 summers
- All work must be done at an approved non-profit agency
- At least half of all your service must be in direct contact with those being served
- You can not be paid for service during school year, but can during summer (e.g. at a summer camp)
- Participate in Bonner Orientation just prior to school starting in August
- Participate in weekly leadership meetings during freshman year
- Participate in week long service immersion trip at end of school year
- Participate in annual Bonner Retreat and monthly meetings

Scholarship Monetary Benefits:

- 8 monthly checks of 237.50
- \$300 book money check at the start of each semester
- Summer stipend of \$1500 (totaling \$3000) for 2 summers of service
- Eligible to apply for summer support money for housing or other expenses (e.g. plane ticket) up to \$2500
- Full financial need met with loan caps
