In addition, students will conduct a brief literature review on a contemporary social problem of their choice and will iterate drafts of their reviews based on peer feedback collected on checklists specifying APA style requirements.</p>						
	<p><b>Related Assessment Approaches and Tools</b></p> <p>Multiple choice exam questions on the second quiz (items 5-12) and the final (items 23-33) will examine student knowledge of APA style guidelines.</p>
