Bonner Scholars make a fouryear commitment to community

Each year, approximately 25 students are selected to make a four-year commitment to being active citizens in the local Richmond community. Bonner Scholars are matched with nonprofits, schools, and governmental agencies in the Richmond metro area that correspond with their interests in social issues and spend 10 hours a week engaging in meaningful work with increasing responsibility. These long-term, reciprocal partnerships lead students to become advocates and allies of the organization and bring consistent and thoughtful assistance to our communities.

In exchange for their work, Bonner Scholars receive a partial scholarship for full-time undergraduate study, as well as financial support for summer community work.
