2018 Member Data from Commission Grantees

Demographics:

- 23,677 members completed the exit survey (80%) response rate)
- Age breakdown:
 - 67%: ages 18-24
 - 25%: ages 25-44
- 3:1 female to male ratio
- 60% White, 24% Black/African American, 7% **Asian**
- Members funded by 775 grants



AmeriCorps Member Theory of Change


Program participants develop along four pathways that we believe are essential in developing the empowerment and preparation necessary to be a change-oriented, active community member.

Motivation for Joining AmeriCorps


People join AmeriCorps for a variety of reasons. How much do you agree that each of the following reasons motivated you to join?





Member Perception on Training Received



Problem Solving Abilities


If you found out about a problem in your community that you wanted to do something about, how well do you think you would be able to do each of the following:








Thinking about your AmeriCorps experience, please indicate how much you agree or disagree with the following statements.








Member Satisfaction with AmeriCorps Service


All things considered, how satisfied are you with your overall AmeriCorps service?






Member Perceptions of AmeriCorps Experience (Cont.)




If a good friend or family member told you he or she was interested in joining AmeriCorps, how would you advise them?
